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The Great Rapture Question:

No doubt, there will be a rapture and after reading this Newsletter and going to the hyperlinks provided you may be persuaded that there are two raptures, one True and one False. We know they have the technology.

There are three positions on the Rapture, Pre-Trib, Mid-Trib and Post Tribulation Rapture.

The Pre-Tribulation presentation goes that the Church is no longer mentioned after Revelation Chapter 4, where the voice of Christ calls John up to heaven with the voice like that of a trumpet saying; "Come up hither."

In one of Perry Stone's works he finds a connection with the 7 day Hebrew Wedding Feast that parallels the seven years of tribulation and gives a convincing presentation that leads one to believe in the Pre-Trib Rapture. <http://www.voe.org>

Our hope is that is the case, however, lets look at the other two; Mid-Trib and Post-Trib presentations and the other possibility of a false rapture.

The Mid-Trib position uses some of the same Scriptures as the Pre-Trib such as this excerpt from 1 Corinthians 15:

1 Corinthians.:15:51: Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 1Co:15:52: In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

In the Interlinear *Greek-English New Testament, The Nestle Marshall* text the Greek straight translation is: I Corinthians: 15:52 Behold[,] a mystery to you I tell: all We shall not fall asleep, but all we shall be changed, in a moment, in a glance of an eye, at the last trumpet; for a trumpet shall sound and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. .

This is different than the Scriptures in: 1 Thessalonians:4:16: For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first.

The Greek in Thessalonians gives no indication of which trumpet:

1 Thessalonians:4:16: because ³[him]self ¹the ²Lord with a word of command, with a voice of an archangel and with a trumpet of God, will descend from heaven, and the dead in Christ will rise again firstly, 17 then we the [ones] living - remaining together with them shall be seized in clouds to a meeting of the Lord in the air; and so always with {the} Lord we shall be. 18 Therefore comfort ye one another with - words these.

So, if it is the first trumpet, that fulfills the Pre-Trib position by Revelation 8, not Chapter 4, in Revelation Chapter 4, the voice of the Lord *sounds* like a trumpet and this is before the final trumpet in Revelation 10 & 11.

Revelation :8:6: And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

The last and seventh trumpet doesn't begin to sound until Revelation 10 and is complete in Chapter 11 when the two witnesses are beheaded and left for three and a half days in the street. Shortly after this the dead in Christ are raised. The dead shall be raised first, then we are caught up.

Re:11:18: And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth.

Revelation:10:7: But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

The mention of the Wedding Feast comes after this in Revelation 19:4: And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. 19:5: And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. 19:6: And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunders, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. 19:7: Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. 19:8: And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. 19:9: And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are

called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

Now after reading these things *if* the last trumpet in 1 Corinthians 52 is the correct timing then that means that there will be a mid-tribulation Rapture, because it is written that the dead will be raised *first* and the timing is fitting that the two witness should be raised along with the dead in Christ and those that are waiting for His Coming. It is also appropriate that they should be included at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

We have been promised that we will be taken from the wrath to come, when the devil is cast upon the earth the Great Wrath and Judgment of God on the devil and his angels begins and continues for 42 months or three and a half years. Shortly after the Two Witnesses are raised from the dead then all the dead in Christ are raised; Re:11:18: And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. This is the rapture. Revelation 12:7: And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, 12:8: And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.12:9: And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. 12:10: And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

12:11: And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

It would also be fitting for the great falling away which will come first, it is probably due to people being disappointed that they were not ruptured out of the beginning of the Tribulation. But remember when the Rapture happens "one will be taken and the other one left."

2 Thessalonians:2:3: Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

Now the Post-Trib position is that the rapture happens right before the return of the Lord and we receive our immortal bodies as we enter the Millennium. Now as to the son of perdition and an answer to there possibly being two raptures, one false and one True here are a number of hyperlinks to search out and study **Project Blue Beam.**

After reading through these you will begin to see the use that some "Shelved" Patents due to the 1952 Secrecy Order for the US Patent Office will be used for. So, there really could be a false rapture using today's suppressed technology and that too would cause a great falling away. All we can say is Lord have mercy on us all; let none of us be deceived. Ask in prayer what you should do to be ready. Know Him intimately and walk with Him all the time, be filled with His Holy Spirit and ask for discernment.

Here is one last thing to think about, most people who believe in a Pre-Trib rapture don't seem to care about the Hebrews and Christians that will be left behind and still saved according to the Word of God. In reality it seems a bit selfish not to care about those who will be left behind whenever the rapture or false rapture occurs.

In the parable of the Ten Virgins; the five wise Virgins had enough oil, a symbol of the Holy Spirit for the wedding ceremony and the five foolish did not have extra oil and were refused oil from the five wise Virgins and later were rejected by the Lord.

The same Great Commission of Christ in the last Chapter of Mark 16 reads;

M'r:16:15: And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. M'r: 16:16: He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. M'r: 16:17: And these signs shall follow them that believe;

In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; Mark:16:18: They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. Mark:16:19: So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. Mark: 16:20: And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Being filled with the Holy Sprit and having extra oil for the lamps comes by asking for it and every time we share the Gospel successfully with others or help the widows, the fatherless and the needy we are filled by The Lord filling them.

It is a matter of care, conscience and love to preach the Gospel to every living creature until the return of Christ. That is done in word and deed.

Help prepare a legal way to avoid the mark of the beast and to feed and shelter Hebrews and Christians that are left behind, because their salvation depends on it.

That is what this work is all about. That is why we are setting up a First Amendment Free Church that is offshore and not subject to the World Bank or the mark of the beast.

As a matter of conscience, care and love why not use some of your time to help make this vision a reality? When Jesus left His Disciples to Ascend on High, He prepared for them and their work after He left.

All the Disciples and Paul gave the same example of providing for them that came after them Spiritually

and physically making not just converts but disciples of Christ.

We should be doing the same thing if we think we are ready for the rapture at any moment. The point being that if you only care about being taken from the Tribulation in a pre-trib Rapture and not helping prepare for those left behind, wouldn't that seem to disqualify one who doesn't care about those that do get left behind?

We receive that extra oil from walking with God and doing His will. Wouldn't it be ironic if that same person were left behind for not caring and doing something to help others and have ready answers and solutions ready for the saved and unsaved when we have the opportunity to prepare a way out of danger?

Consider the above study, why would the words "final trumpet" be in 1 Corinthians in the Greek if it did not mean the seventh trumpet of Revelation when the dead are raised then we are raptured?

That is part of the reason we are trying to set things up so that if we are taken (for no man knows the hour or the day) we can still leave behind the necessary institutions set up to help the remaining Hebrews and Christians and those who will be saved during the Great Tribulation and many will need the aid we are beginning to establish.

In the end, it may work out that we have prepared for ourselves the very thing needed in a Great time of trouble. Matthew:10:22: And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

Matthew :24:13: But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And again in Luke: 21:19: In your patience possess ye your souls.

We still hope and pray that we are excused from the Great Tribulation, and like the parable of the ten virgins, five wise and five foolish, our desire for all that that we will be continually filled with the Oil of the Holy Spirit by coupling obedience, faith with works according to the many examples are given in The Holy Bible.

Another way to look at the Rapture Question is this; if there is no Pre-Trib Rapture, how disappointed will you be, would you doubt God? Or if the False Rapture happens?

But, if the Rapture is Mid-Trib and you are preparing for dealing with the consequences wouldn't you be surprised if it happened earlier in a Pre-Trib Rapture? And we hope and pray that be the case.

In either case, know Him, spend time with his people be filled with His Holy Spirit at all times, that is the way to be ready for it is written that no man knows the hour or the day.

Which in your mind would be the wisest position to take? To prepare for a Mid-Trib Rapture and store up for those left behind.

That is the final harvest. In any case He is coming soon

In no way preparing for those left behind would prevent being Rapture in a Pre-Tib scenario. Doing the LORD's will makes us ready in either event.

There is a lot of room and a lot of work to be done to accomplish our mission statement which is written in; *The Stone Soup Proposal.*

1 John:4:18: There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. Luke:21:19: In your patience possess ye your souls.
